

Flights on the Tashkent - Goa - Tashkent route launched

In honour of the launch of the new destination, a solemn ceremony was held at Manohar International Airport, where representatives of the airline, BSP-consolidators and airport management, as a sign of respect for Indian traditions, jointly lit candles and cut a festive cake.



Alexander Goncharenko was the first passenger to check-in for flight HY430. In total, Uzbekistan Airways welcomed more than 80 passengers on board: students going to Novosibirsk to study and travelers wishing to discover Uzbekistan.
